Question 1: To see if the Town will vote to authorize the issuance of up to \$7,657,193 in general obligation bonds or notes of the Town and appropriate of the proceeds thereof to pay the costs of design, construction, and equipping of a new public works and school transportation and maintenance facility located at property on Windham Center Road and costs of issuance of the bonds, with the details of such borrowing (including provisions that the bonds may be prepaid or subject to call for redemption with or without premium and the dates, maturities, denominations, and interest rates) to be determined by the Town Council?
