

Sidewalks on Route 302 in North Windham

Through a grant from the Portland Area Comprehensive Transportation System (PACTS), the Town of Windham has been awarded funds to improve pedestrian facilities along Route 302 (Roosevelt Trail) in North Windham from Boody's Corner (Roosevelt Trail/Tandberg Trail intersection) to Franklin Drive. This project implements a portion of the recommendations that came out of the 21st Century Plan whose goal was to establish a renewed sense of place through complete streets. The project includes the following components that came out of a Preliminary Engineering Design in 2016:

- Build new ADA-compliant sidewalks on the west side of Route 302 between Boody's Corner and Franklin Drive and provide additional crosswalks at all signalized intersections.
- Rebuild the sidewalk, where necessary, on the east side of Route 302 to conform with ADA requirements.
- Install landscaping and pedestrian scale lighting along the sidewalks on the east and west sides of Route 302.

Through the partnership with PACTS, the Town will receive \$1,111,990 to help pay for the estimated \$2,300,000 project. The engineering design will be initiated in the winter of 2022 and construction is anticipated to occur in 2024.
